LILT Student Foreign Language Competition is an opportunity for language students of all levels to submit original works in any of the several categories listed below which will then be judged and awarded prizes.

MEMBERSHIP: You must be a 2012 paid-up member of LILT by **DECEMBER 31, 2011**, in order to enter your students.

DUE DATE AND POSTMARK: Your envelope or package containing your check, entries and completed registration forms can only bear a **UNITED STATES POSTAL POSTMARK** by **March 1st**.

COMPETITION CATEGORIES:

- 1. Written Original Poetry**
Topic: There is no specific topic. All subjects for original poetry are acceptable and they must be in good taste.
- 2. Written Original Essay**
Topic: "Cell phones: My Right Or Not"
- 3. International Dance Video**
Topic: There is no specific topic. All types of dance are acceptable that are part of the culture of target language being studied and must be in good taste*.
- 4. International Vocal Music Video**
Topic: There is no specific topic. All songs are acceptable and must be in good taste*.
- 5. Language Production Video**
Topic: "A Problem While Dining Out In A Target Language Country" - See note below*.
- 6. Poetry Recitation Video**
Topic: There is no specific topic. All subjects for poetry recitation are acceptable and must be in good taste. Must be level appropriate*.
- 7. Multi-Media Computer Program**
Topic: "A Virtual Tour Of Target Language City" - See note below**.

8. ASL Song Interpretation Video

Topic: There is no specific topic. All songs are acceptable and must be in good taste*.

9. ASL Poetry Interpretation Video

Topic: There is no specific topic. All subjects for poetry interpretation are acceptable and must be in good taste. Must be level appropriate*.

* ***Acceptable media submissions for the SIX (6) VIDEO PRODUCTION COMPETITIONS (III, IV, V, VI, VIII, and IX) will include ONLY VHS tapes or DVDs that are playable on a Windows operating system. Flash Drives and CDs cannot be submitted.***

** ***Submissions for the Multi-Media Computer Program (VII) Competition must be on CD only.***
