



LILT Professional Development Winter Workshops 2010

LILT is offering a series of two-hour professional development workshops for Long Island L.O.T.E. teachers. Before registering, check with your district to ascertain if prior approval is required, if credit will be granted and if verification of attendance is necessary. Attendance certificates will be distributed at the end of each workshop. Participants may enroll in as many workshops as they wish. Weekday sessions will be held from 4:00 to 6:00 PM at the school indicated in the course description. Saturday sessions will be held from 10 AM to Noon.

Cost: \$15 per session for LILT members / \$25 per session for non-members
